

Checklist: Packing representative sample materials

The packing of the test samples to be submitted must satisfy specific quality requirements in order to protect the samples and to guarantee accurate, reproducible and meaningful test results.

The following points must be noted:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Test samples must be packed individually in tear resistant polyethylene film or polyethylene bags. (To avoid contamination during transport) 	<input type="checkbox"/>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The samples should be wrapped twice and sealed with adhesive tape. 	<input type="checkbox"/>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Packing decoration materials: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Test samples should be airtight and individually packed in clear plastic bags (essential for emission testing). 2.
